### CASTLE DANGER SUBORDINATE SERVICE DISTRICT SEWER RATE HEARING APRIL 12, 2022

The Annual CDSSD Wastewater Rate Hearing was held on Tuesday, April 12th, 2022, in the Board Meeting Room at 1924 Town Road, for the purpose of reviewing proposed sewer rates for 2022.

Present were Silver Creek Supervisors: Greg Hull, Chuck Voss, and Chris Jaeger; Clerk Alison Oftedahl, Deputy Clerk Katie Anderson; Wastewater Operator Mike Hoops and Town Operations and Facilities Manager Jody Reineccius.

Visitors Present: None

Chairman Voss called the CDSSD Rate Hearing to order at 6:35 p.m. and asked Wastewater Operator Hoops to recap the year. Hoops presented his annual report included below:

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The Board then reviewed the wastewater financial recap. Ending balance for Sewer Enterprise was \$56,864.50, and for Sewer Enterprise Replacement was \$96,944.29.

The Board proposed holding residential rates to the 2021 level. Motion Voss, Second Hull, to set the residential at \$55.00 per month and \$17.00 for small structures. Carried unanimously. Commercial rates changed as result of their usage. Motion Hull, Second Voss to accept the commercial rates as presented at \$16.00 per 1,000 gallons. Carried unanimously.

The Clerks were asked about appeals via mail, email, or phone. The Clerks reported that nothing had been received. Hearing no objections, motion Hull, second Voss to adopt Resolution <u>2022-6</u>. The Resolution included below was adopted upon roll-call vote as follows: Supervisor Chuck Voss - yea, Supervisor Greg Hull – yea; Supervisor Chris Jaeger –abstained due to conflict of interest.

1. Late payment fee:

**Residential** – 1.50% per month on outstanding balance

Late fees will be assessed 45 days from billing date

Shut off notice will be issued at 90 days from billing date unless board votes to suspend it.

Commercial – 1.50% per month on outstanding balances

Late fees will be assessed at 30 and 60 days from billing date

Shut off notice will be issued at 90 days from billing date unless the board votes to suspend it.

2. Account transfer fee: \$25.00

3. Sewer turn–on fee: \$100.00

4. Sewer shut-off fee: \$100.00

5. New Account Application Fee: \$550

- 6. Residential Access Fee: \$8,000.00
- 7. Commercial Access Fee: \$6,331.48/100,000 gallons per year
- 8. Sewage-dumping fee for trucked-in sewage: \$21.00/1000 gallons septage and \$6.00/1000 gallons domestic strength wastewater. Ponds are not open in the winter. If dumping is needed, hauler shall be responsible for providing their own snow removal equipment to access the pond site waste.
- 9. In the event I&I is discovered or identified as coming from a connection, the Board shall have the option of assessing a monthly penalty of \$100.00 until satisfactory repairs are made.
